Shenzhen

Location

Shenzhen is a major city in Guangdong Province, which is located on the south-eastern tip of China. The city is situated on the eastern bank of the Pearl River, with Hong Kong at its immediate south. Shenzhen is the first and one of the most successful Special Economic Zones of China, having direct jurisdiction over 6 administration districts and 4 management new districts.

Population

Shenzhen was once a border town with population about 30,000, yet it has grown drastically into a modern metropolis over the last 3 decades – by year 2013, Shenzhen had reached population of 10.63 million, in which 3.1 million were local permanent residents.

Climate

Shenzhen has subtropical marine climate. The weather is generally temperate to mild with plenty of sunshine and rain. The city is generally frost-free in winter. In spring it is usually warm and foggy. At summer times it is hot and humid. In cool, dry autumn around September, the average temperature is about 26 degrees Celsius.

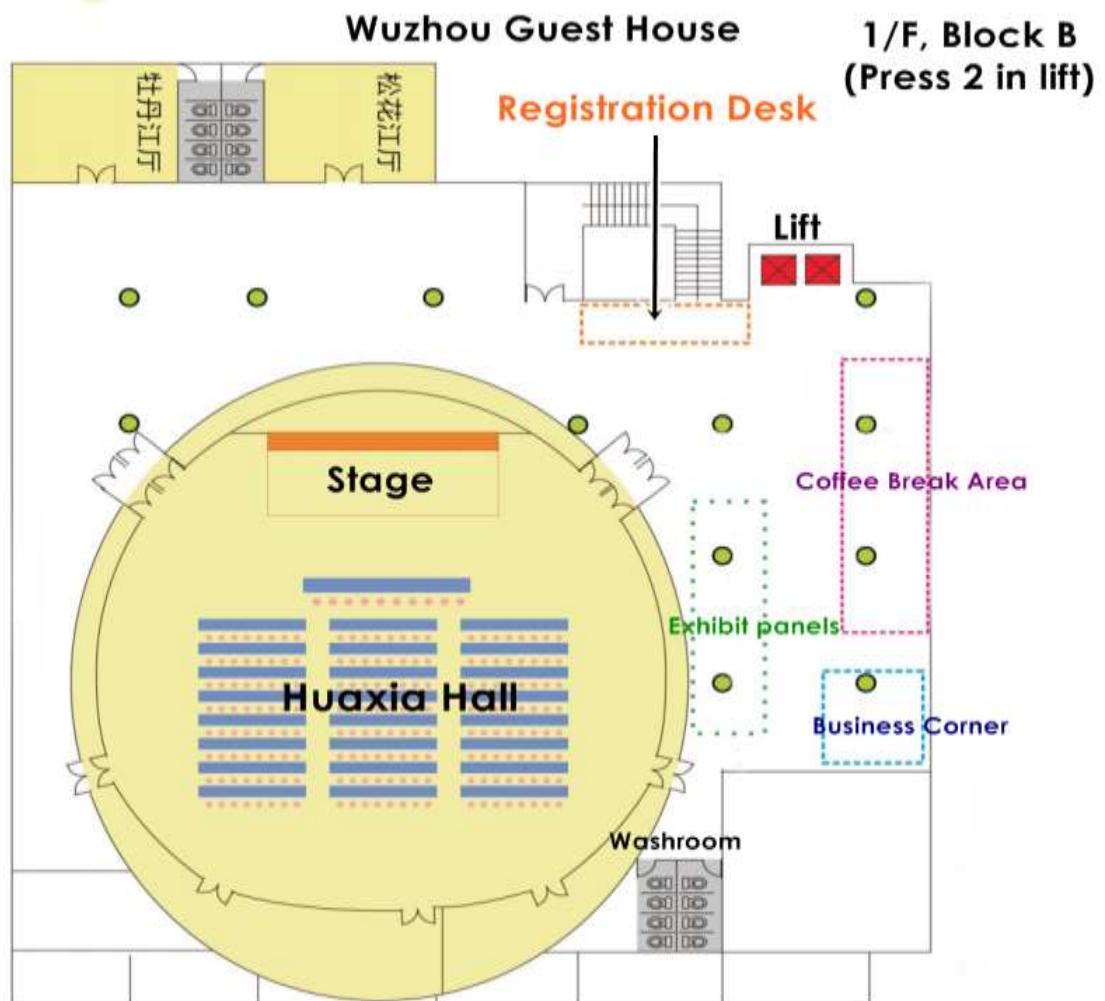

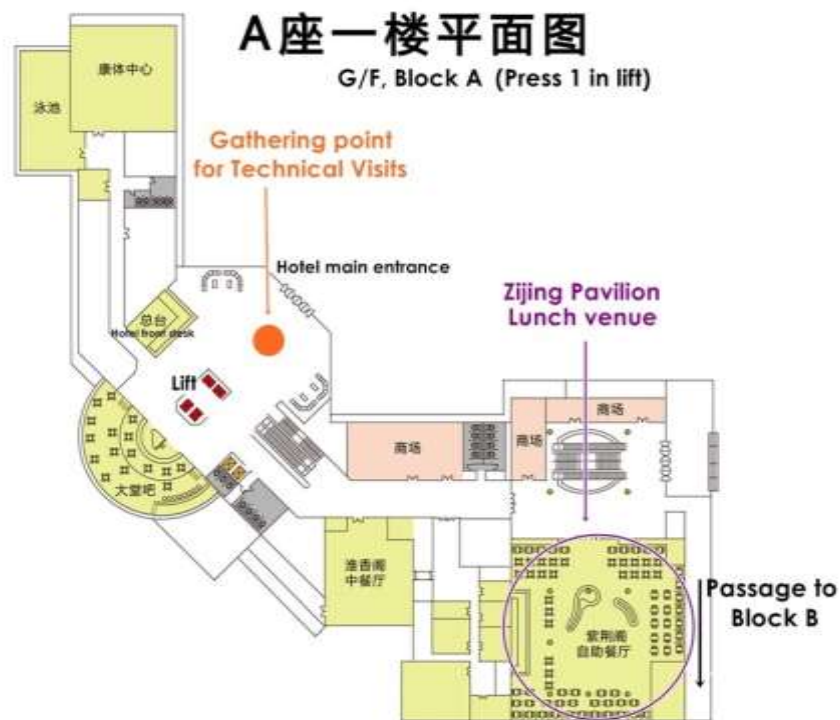

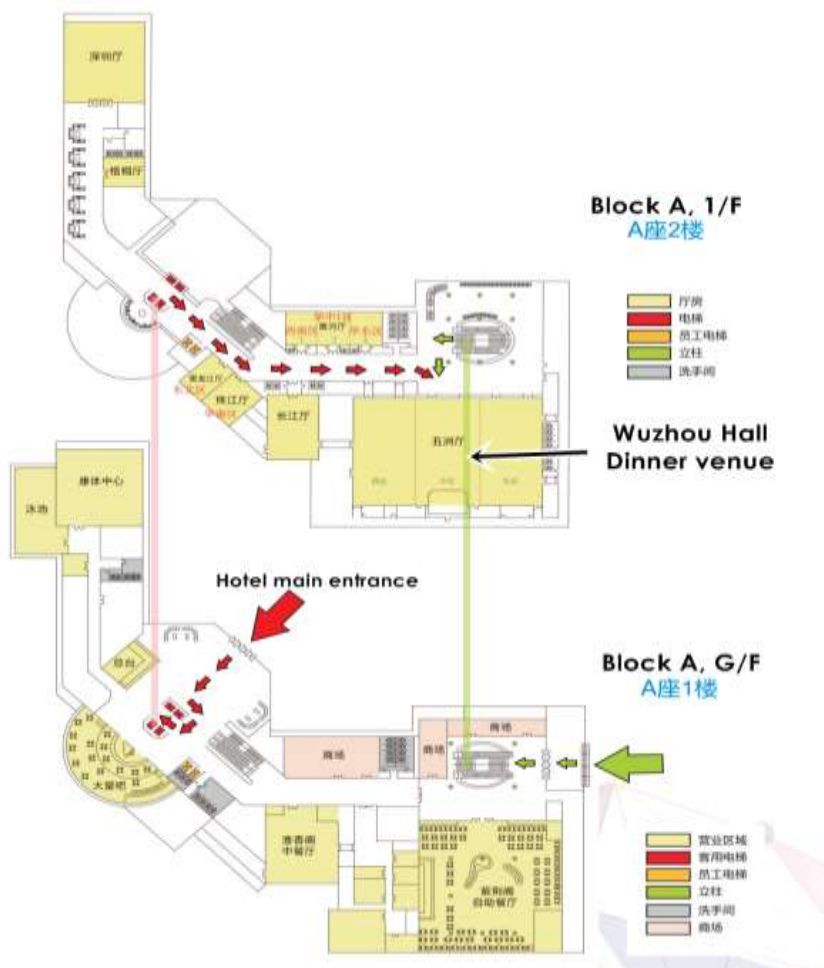

OTHER INFORMATION

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The Chinese Yuan Renminbi (RMB) is the currency of China.

You can exchange Renminbi at most banks in Hong Kong. At Hong Kong International Airport, currency exchange counters are open from early morning until late at night. There are also exchange stores near the Hong Kong – Shenzhen border. Major credit cards are accepted at hotels and branded stores in big shopping malls, however many of the smaller stores do not accept credit cards.

*Exchange rate: 1 USD = 6.368 RMB / 100 HKD = 80 RMB (September 2015)

ELECTRICITY & VOLTAGE

The Voltage in China is 220V 50Hz. A common type of outlet is shown below. This outlet can accept the standard Type A and common Type I plugs as well as Type C plugs. Both the upper and lower outlets can be used simultaneously.
